Phonics / English

In Phonics we will be looking at the level 3 sounds and learning a few sounds each week. We will be recapping and building on the level 2 sounds that children have previously learnt. Please continue to practise these at home.

In English the children are focusing on pencil grip and writing small words and labels. They will be looking at the sounds that they learn in phonics and will practise writing them correctly.

The children will be reading the story 'Supertato' and 'Superworm', to support their learning about Superheroes, both fictional and real life heroes in our community.

We will be learning about the different emergency services and what their jobs involve.
