# Phonics / English

In Phonics we will be continuing to look at the level 3 sounds and learning a few sounds each week. The children have begun to blend their sounds and will continue to blend to make and read words.

In English the children will be using their level 2 and 3 sounds to support their writing. They will also be learning and using tricky words like 'she' as well.

The children are learning a selection of Traditional Tales, in particular: Goldilocks and the three bears and The three little pigs. Toward the end of the term we will be moving on to look at 'The Jolly Postman'. Children will be retelling stories, writing about characters and moving on to letter writing toward the end of term.
