Science

In Science this term, Oak Class will be learning what happens to humans as they go into old age. The children will learn what changes happen to the human body during this phase of life.

Geography

In geography, we will be learning about North America. The children will use atlases and digital maps to identify the key physical features of North America and describe the climates and biomes of different regions across North America.

Art

In art we will be using the book called 'The Viewer' by Shaun Tan as inspiration to create a viewer. We will also be using clay to create a autocritique 3D plaque.





Computing

This term the children will be learning about databases in real life as well as how to use databases, search engines and visual representations.

History

In history, children will learn about the Atlantic slave trade Experiences of slaves during this period (plantations in America) and the abolition of slave trade / slavery

English

Our main class texts this term consists of one book and a film clip.

The book is called 'The Viewer' by Shaun Tan and tells a strange and mysterious story across time. Children will use the book as inspiration to write in the style of a newspaper report and generate a free verse poem. We will also use a short animation to inspire a flashback style narrative.

Mathematics

This term the children will be revisiting work on addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

Children will build on the work in Term 3 on 2D shapes to learn about 3D shapes. Co-ordinates and quadrants will also be investigated.

As the SATS draw closer, Year 6 will have the opportunity to look at SATS style questions looking at how best to answer them for maximum marks.

Physical Education (PE)
