Science

In Science this term, Oak Class will be learning about materials and their properties and will be learning how to use the system of scientific enquiry to conduct a number of investigations

Computing

This term the children will be learning about collecting data in spreadsheets. Formatting, using formula and event planning.

Geography

In geography, we will be learning about the coast line of the UK. We will:

Identify coastal areas, features of the UK + how different coastal features are formed Use maps and place names to identify when, where and why settlements developed Explore why people choose to live by the sea and how the reasons for this might have changed over time

How water and weather can change coastal landscapes

Impact humans have on the coast Impact of changing landscapes on local and global communities

Art

In art we will be looking at the world of collage. We will study the artist Matthew Cusick and experiment with making our own collage images.



English

In English this term we will be using the book 'Flotsam' by David Weisner to inspire writing a balanced argument.

We will look at the key features and practice writing an a balanced argument as a class before the children have a go at their own.

There will also be time to learn some comprehension skills.



Physical Education (PE)

In PE this term, we will continue to rehearse the dance routine. We will also be learning football skills. In addition, there will be netball tournaments and hockey tournaments at HCC.

PHSF

In PHSE this term, we will be exploring the nature of our relationships with those people in our lives. This will include on line safety and our relationship with technology. Are we spending too much time on line?

French (MfL)

Oak Class will be learning about directions. How to recognize them, read them and respond to directional language. A useful skill if you cannot afford the data roaming charges abroad for your phone!
