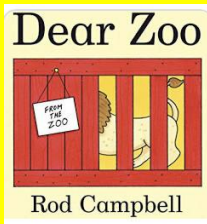


Phonics / English

In Phonics we will be focusing on level 4 sounds which will help the children decode longer words when they're reading.

In English the children will be using their sounds to support their writing. We will be looking at a variety of stories over the term but the story 'Dear Zoo' will be our theme for the term.

Each week we will be focusing on different animals and learning about them. We will be writing facts and learning how to look after different animals, asking the question - would they make a good pet?

Maths

In maths this term we will be continuing our learning about number and learning how to add and subtract small amounts.

Children will be consolidating their knowledge of number and pattern. They will continue to count beyond 20.

Other areas of Development

This term the children will be learning about animals and how to look after them. They will learn about the different habitats that they live in.

Children will find out about different types of animals and whether they live on land, in the sky or in the water. They will make models of animals and design homes for them.

In PSHE the children will be learning about themselves and their feelings and preparing for the transition to Year 1.
