

French

This term we will be learning about 'My French House'. The children will describe a house and will use language to describe the items that can be found within their houses.

Science

In Science, we will be focusing on Earth and Space. During this topic, we will explore the history of space exploration, the moon, the Earth and the planets within our solar system.

Computing

In our computing lessons, the children will be learning about physical computing by programming and debugging Microbits. They will explore creating code with loops and selection.

English

Books: *Hidden figures* by Margot Lee Shetterly and *The Jamie Drake Equation* by Christopher Edge. In our English lessons, we will learn all about the moon landing before writing a newspaper report on the topic. Our lessons will support the children in their writing by focusing on key features such as direct and indirect speech and using parentheses. During the second half of term, we will be writing a science fiction story! In preparation for this exciting narrative, children will learn how to use dialogue to move the action along and let their imaginations fly when creating futuristic characters.

Maths

We will be starting this term with a focus on fractions. As part of this, the children will develop their understanding of how to compare, order and calculate with fractions. They will also work on written strategies for multiplication and division. The children will continue to have the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge of these areas in concrete, visual and abstract ways, developing reasoning and problem-solving strategies as they learn.

PSHE

This term, the children will be learning about relationships. This will include topics such as family, behaviour in person and online, collaboration and stereotypes.

Geography

Within our geography sessions this term, we will explore different geographical features from across the globe, taking a closer look at our planet's major continents.

Art & Design Technology

In our art lessons, the children will be exploring mechanical systems and using these to design and make a moving rocket.
