

English

This term the children will be looking at the story 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake and will be labelling pictures and writing sentences about the story.

They will also be writing simple instructions connected to our Pirate theme.

Phonics

We will be looking at level 4 phonics which is where children apply their knowledge of sounds learnt to decoding and reading longer words.

Children will continue to consolidate their level 3 sounds and will focus on writing and reading them.

RE

Children will be investigating what times and stories are special and why they are special. We will be looking at different Bible stories and discuss why they are special.

Understanding the World

Learning will be about oceans and what an island is. We will be learning about different types of boats and how they have changed.

Maths

Children will be continuing to count to 20 and will be learning addition and subtraction skills. Children will be moving on to look at sharing and grouping amounts along with understanding more about shape and the position of objects.

PSHE

The topic is 'Changing Me'. We will focus on the themes, tolerance, Care for community, work, money, winning and losing and change.
