English

Our class text will be The Last Bear.

Book: The Rainbow Bear by Michael Morpurgo

In English the children will be using the above text, and some cross curricular subjects, to:

- Create free verse poetry
- Write a setting descriptions
- Write an informal letter to entertain
- Write a newspaper article about Polar Bears

Spellings

Spellings will be set weekly from the Year 3/4 recommended word list. These spellings will be practised in school and sent home for the children to continue to learn for homework.

Spellings will be checked weekly on a Monday and an assessment carried out at the end of term.

Reading

We will be doing Guided Comprehension on a Monday, in which children are able to explore lots of different texts and media sources, talk about what they have read/seen and build up comprehension skills.

Children will bring home reading books we expect children to read at home with an adult and record this in their reading records.

DT and Art

The children will be studying David McEwon and using his styles and techniques to create landscapes. They will also be learning about Matthew Henson and having a DT day to make mini toboggans.

Computing

The children will be learning how to create media, including creating pictures and freeze frames.

Our online safety lesson will focus on buying safely online.

Term 2 Frozen

Are the icebergs really in danger?

Topic

Our topic this term is **Frozen.**

The children will be looking at the Polar Regions, comparing the Artic Circle and Antarctica, creating a non-chronological report all about Polar Bears and also exploring the impact of Climate Change and how this is affecting the World.

The children will also be looking into the history of explorations of the Polar Regions by studying Matthew Henson.

The children will be thinking about the Trimurti, how Hindu's worship at home, exploring the link between the Diwali story and Hindu deities and how Hindu's beliefs affect their actions.

They will also be thinking about Mary and the Annunciation in the build up to Christmas.

Maths

There will also be a weekly fluency and arithmetic lesson.
