English

Our class text will be The Wild Robot by Peter Brown

Book: The Tin Forest by Helen Ward

In English the children will be using the above text, and some cross curricular subjects, to:

- Write their own character and setting descriptions
- Persuasive Posters and Leaflets
- Retelling a familiar story before writing their own version of the same story

Spellings

We will be starting a new spelling system this Term, more information to follow shortly.

Reading

We will be doing Guided Comprehension on a Monday, in which children are able to explore lots of different texts and media sources, talk about what they have read/seen and build up comprehension skills.

Children will bring home reading books we expect children to read at home with an adult and record this in their reading records.

<u>DT</u>

This term has a DT focus. The children will be analysing toys with moving parts before designing, making and evaluating their own robots with lever/ pulley style moving parts.

Computing

The children will be learning how to create branching databases and the purpose for these.

Our online safety lesson will focus on how we can keep ourselves safe online.

Term 3 Robots

Topic

Our topic this term is Robots.

Through our topic and using the class texts the children will be learning all about Robots and how they work.

The children will also be looking at Mountains, how they are formed, their climates and why tourism is important for these areas.



RE- What does it mean to be a Hindu today?

The children will be thinking about what does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today by exploring how Hindu's worship at home, understand how they show their faith in their communities, the importance of religious festivals and be able to describe how religious festivals are celebrated.

Maths

All children will also have a weekly times table lesson where we will be using timestable.co.uk, chanting and recall games. The children will have their own log in for the website where they can practice at home as well as in school.

There will also be a weekly fluency and arithmetic lesson.

Science

Forces and Magnets

In their science lessons the children will be learning:

- To be able to identify the forces acting on objects
- To be able to investigate the effects of friction on different surfaces
- To be able to sort magnetic and non-magnetic materials
- To be able to investigate the strength of magnets
- To be able to explore magnetic poles
- To be able to explain that magnets attract some materials
