

Maths

This term the Year Threes and Fours will start the term by revisiting multiplication and division, where they will begin to use the formal method of written multiplication and division as well as exploring ways to strengthen their own mental methods.

Next we will cover length and perimeter, meeting Sammy the Snail and doing lots of practical activities to be able to understand equivalent measures.

At the end of term the children will begin their fractions topic, understanding numerators and denominators and ordering and comparing fractions and mixed numbers.

Science

This term we will be learning all about electricity.

We will create simple circuits, carry out investigations involving batteries, lamps, buzzers and switches, and discover what are conductors & insulators.

We will also link science and DT by creating our own torches.

PE

For P.E. this term, the children will be creating routines in gymnastics with Mrs Snelling on Tuesdays and on Wednesdays will learn hockey, led by Mr Papper. All children will require shin pads and gum shields in school for Wednesday's Lessons.

Computing

Our e-safety lesson looks at plagiarism and how to use others work respectfully.

The focus of our weekly lessons is events and actions using Scratch and learning this new programming environment.

Music

In Music, with a South-African theme, children will develop their rhythm, singing and notation skills.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at our Christian Value of Perseverance.

What is perseverance and why is it so important? Children will also continue to use the Reflection Area in the classroom for prayer and quiet reflection.

In our RE lessons, we will be looking at the Islamic Faith, and asking the *Big Question*; How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?

Fantastical Adventures

Term Three has both a history and geography element to it.

In History the children will be looking at the Vikings, and how their arrival affected the power struggle in England. In geography we will be exploring the UK by reading & creating maps with keys, using a compass to find and give directions, we will also study different land features by looking at aerial images and using technology.

Art & Design

As well as creating a torch in our DT lessons the children will also be studying the artist and architect Friedensreich Hundertwasser and creating their own magical, fantasy inspired building as part of a group project.

The children will require a selection of junk modelling for their final construction later in the term.

French

In French we will look at Birthday Celebrations.

Year 3/4 will learn to say the numbers 1-31, read and calculate Maths sums correctly, match French months to their English equivalents, ask when someone's birthday is and say when their birthday is and compare similarities and differences between birthdays in the UK and France.
