

Science

In Science, we will be focusing on properties and changes of materials. They will learn to identify, classify and group materials by their properties. The children will carry out investigations and experience a range of reversible and irreversible changes.

French

This term we will be learning about French music celebrations. The children will learn to name musical instruments and types of music, expressing opinions about music in extended sentences.

Computing

In our computing lessons, the children will be writing programs and using selection to control outcomes. They will design a quiz in response to a given task and implement it as a program.

English

Books: *Our Tower* by Joseph Coelho and *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* by Lewis Carroll.

In our English lessons, we will explore the magical genre of fantasy. Our lessons will support the children by building up techniques for describing a fantasy setting and character before creating their own mystical narratives. Later in the term, the children will also have the opportunity to apply their creativity to some non-fiction writing through the form of an instructional text. The children will learn to use a variety of punctuation, sentence structures and linking devices.

PSHE
