

English: This term we will be exploring two texts; The Secret of Black Rock and Snail and the Whale. We will be using these to help us write setting descriptions and letters. We will be looking at the features of both, what makes a good description and letter and then writing our own. As always, the children will have daily phonics lessons and regular reading opportunities.

Music- This term we are taking part in Create Music's; Old Woman in a Vinegar Bottle. Children will be learning songs, Makaton and taking part in activities ready for our performance in May.

Computing: Our focus this term is Digital Music and Being kind online. Children will be creating music digitally, creating patterns and music for a given purpose. Children will also be looking at how we stay safe online; looking at websites and key searches as well as how we can be kind online and what a digital footprint is.

Maths: This term we will be focusing on length and height, statistics and money. We will be measuring in cm and m, naming and identifying coins and notes, as well as being able to combine to make amounts and creating our own tables and pictograms. We will be very practical this term with the rulers, meter sticks and coins out to support our learning.

Year 1 & 2

History / Geography:

Our topic this term is Sea Explorers. We will be starting off our learning by revisiting the continents and seas, through song. Then each week we will be looking at different sea explorers over time. We will be exploring their work, equipment, what they do and how they have contributed to History and Marine Biology.

RE: Who Do Christians Say Made the World?

By the end of this unit children will know that Christians believe that God created the world. We will be reading and retelling the Christian and Jewish creation story. We will look at how the Creation story affects how Christians live their lives and give some examples of what Christians might do. We will also be asking questions about our world and explore how we can look after it.

PSHE: Friendships

Friendships are our focus this term. We will be exploring what makes a good friend, the importance of friendship and trust as well as knowing what to do when something goes wrong.
