

English

This term we are focusing on the story 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake and the children will be using previously learnt skills and applying them to some adventure story writing. Children will also look at instruction writing and poetry as the term goes on.

Music: This term, children will be learning about musical symbols through an *under the sea* theme. They will explore how sounds can represent sea creatures, experimenting with tempo and dynamics, and create simple pieces of music.

Computing

Children will be focusing on computer programming this term and will be using the scratch software to write commands and debug a program.

Online Safety:

We are reviewing online safety and finding out how the children will deal with different scenarios.

Maths

In Term 6 the children will be learning about fractions and moving on to focus on time and measures. Children will be learning about mass, weight and length and finding out how to use them in real world situations.

Year 1 and 2

History / Geography

By the end of term 6 children will know about the oceans of the world and have an understanding of what an island is.

Children will also learn about how boats have changed over the years.

RE

This term, the children will be investigating how we should care for the world and for others. They will be looking at why it is so important and looking at this through different religious perspectives.

Pirates Ahoy

PSHE

This term's topic is 'Changing Me'. The children will focus on the themes, tolerance, Care for community, work, money, winning and losing and change. In RSE, children will learn about how to share their feelings and worries, understand appropriate and inappropriate contact, understand the difference between secrets and surprises and know when to tell an adult.

Value: Truthfulness

Science

This term, the focus is on plants. The children will look at different plants and trees in our environment and they will look at their structure and what we can do to ensure that they survive in their habitat.

Phonics

Year 1 children will focus on level 5 sounds and how to add suffixes to root words. In Year 2, the children will look at alternative spellings for words and homophones.

PE

This term, children will be working towards our annual sports day through a series of speed and agility events. They will also begin to develop cricket skills such as throwing, catching and striking, while developing teamwork and coordination.

Art / DT

Children will be investigating and using materials to build a pirate ship.
