

English: In English, we will begin by exploring stories 'The Great Race', 'Rosie's Walk' and 'The Odd Egg'. We will sequence and retell each story, make predictions about what may happen next, and write a set of instructions explaining how to care for a creature.

We will also be celebrating our favourite books on World Book Day!

Phonics: Level 3

Week 1: Focus sound: or, ur. Tricky word: they

Week 2: Focus sound: ow, oi. Tricky word: here

Week 3: Focus sound: ear, air. Tricky words: all, are

Week 4: Focus sounds: ure, er. Tricky words: Revision of all Level 3 tricky words.

Week 5: Revision and Assessment

Communication and Language: We will continue to share our ideas in small groups and with a familiar adult as well as responding to what we have heard by asking questions and saying what we think.

PE: Gymnastics – We will develop confidence in movements. Experience jumping, sliding, rolling, moving over and under apparatus and develop coordination and gross motor skills.

Manipulation and Coordination – We will send and receive a variety of objects with different body parts. Work with others to control objects in space. Coordinate body parts in a variety of activities and in different ways.

Out of the Egg!



Maths: We will be working with numbers up to 10, focusing on representing and comparing 9 and 10, finding one more and one less within 10, exploring number composition, and practising number bonds and doubles. We will also be exploring 3D shapes.

PSHE: We will be learning about our bodies and how we keep ourselves healthy. We will be learning about the importance of food, exercise and sleep. **Career focus:** Farmer

Understanding the World: We will be looking at different kinds of animals that hatch out of eggs, thinking about where they come from and what they need. We will be learning about the celebration of Lunar New Year. We will be exploring the season of spring and learning about different spring flowers and what plants need to grow.

RE: We will begin the term focussing on our value of Justice and how this is reflected in the Bible and in our own lives.

This term we will be celebrating Easter and talking about why Easter is an important time of year for Christians.
