## History

This term our topic is 'Adventure'. Firstly, we will learn about the tensions that led to the outbreak of WW1. Following this, we will explore how soldiers were recruited through propaganda and how this differed to the reality of fighting in the trenches. The children will also explore the theme of polar exploration by following Shackleton's journey to the Antarctic.

## **English**

This term we will be reading the book 'War Games' by Michael Foreman. This story will set the scene for our topic and will be a starting point for a variety of different writing activities including poetry, letter writing, speeches and short stories. The children will also be reading 'Armistice Runner' by Tom Palmer in our reading sessions to further develop their comprehension skills. Throughout their writing opportunities, the children will learn to organise their work to good effect by varying sentence structures and linking devices between paragraphs. They will also have a continued focus on choosing appropriate vocabulary and punctuation to communicate their ideas.

### **PSHE**

This term, the children will be thinking carefully about ourselves and what it means to be me! The children will be thinking about themselves as a unique individual and how the cope with tricky emotions and situations.

### <u>Music</u>

In music lessons this term, the children will be learning about the dimensions of music through listening to music and singing. For Year 6 children, this will form the rehearsal for our 'One Voice' concert at Glyndebourne.

## Science

We will be focusing on 'Electricity' in our science lessons this term. The children will learn about electrical safety and how to draw circuit diagrams using scientific symbols. They will have the opportunity to plan and conduct an investigation using electrical circuits.

## Geography

Within our geography sessions this term, we will explore how Europe has been shaped over time. The children will be studying maps from the past and comparing the physical and human features of our country to more recent, digital maps.

## Art/ Design Technology

In our art lessons, the children will explore the work of Paul Nash and use this to create their own scenes from the battlefields. They will also have the opportunity to create propaganda posters. In DT, the children will be designing and creating a model lighthouse.

## <u>French</u>

This term our theme is 'Portraits'. In these lessons we will learn how to describe people.
