

PSHE/Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be talking about keeping healthy and why it's important to exercise and eat healthily.

We will be exploring the different food groups and what we need them each for within our bodies.

We will be talking about friendship and how we make friends and keep friends!

We will be looking at our similarities and differences and talking about how brilliant it is that we're all unique!

This term's value is Forgiveness.

Communication and Language

This term we will be continuing to develop our speaking, listening and questioning skills through lots of role-play and hot seating in role as different storybook characters.

We will be sharing our favourite stories.

Computing-

We will be programming robots to follow our story maps.

We will also be exploring entering data and making pictograms to show our data.

Physical Development

This term we will be continuing to explore the different movements our bodies can make, practising our running, hopping and skipping.

We are working on moving our bodies in time to music through dance.

We will also be continuing to work on our fine motor skills, using tools such as scissors and paintbrushes effectively and developing our letter formation.

We will be exploring yoga in the classroom and focusing on moving with control and co-ordination.

English/Literacy

In literacy we will be exploring traditional tales, from Goldilocks and the Three Bears to The Three Little Pigs and the Jolly Postman. We will be exploring characters and describing them. We will be writing speech bubbles, labels and letters for the characters.

We will be retelling stories in different ways and writing our own traditional tales.

We will also be celebrating our favourite book characters on World Book Day!

RE:

In RE this term we will be learning the story of Easter and talking about why this time of year is so important to Christians.

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Mathematics

This term we will begin by exploring measures. We will be exploring mass, capacity, height and length in a range of hands on ways!

We will also be continuing to develop our understanding of place value.

Our Reception children will be focussing on their numbers to 10 and our Year 1 children will be continuing to develop their place value within 50.

We will be revising and revisiting our understanding of 3D shapes, talking about their properties. We will link this to our house building for the three little pigs!

Understanding the World

Science

We will be looking at different materials and deciding what would be best to build a house from for the Three Little Pigs.

We will also be making predictions in simple experiments and talking about reversible and irreversible changes.

We will be exploring the season of spring!

History/Geography

We will be marking International Women's Day by learning about some inspiring historical females!

We will be continuing to develop our mapping skills creating our own story maps and directing each other around them. We will be exploring the 4 points of the compass when mapping our local area.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring our traditional tales through our role-play areas inside and out.

Music
