Science

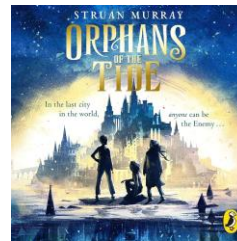
Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of 3D Modelling. We will explore how to plan, design and create our own 3D models using software.

English

This term we will be reading the books 'Orphans of the Tide' by Struan Murray and 'The Tempest' by William Shakespeare. These stories will set the scene for our topic and will be a starting point for a variety of different writing activities including Myths & Legends. Throughout their writing opportunities, the children will learn to structure their work to good effect using varying sentence structures and linking devices between paragraphs. They will also have a continued focus on choosing appropriate vocabulary and punctuation to communicate their ideas. Additionally, the children will have a large focus on play scripts and drama this term as they prepare their end of year production.

Maths

Throughout this term we will be regularly revisiting and consolidating our learning on number and calculation. Alongside this, we will be learning about statistics and solving problems with different types of measurement. The children will continue to have the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge of these areas in concrete, visual and abstract ways, developing reasoning and problem solving strategies as they learn.

PSHE

This term, the children will be learning about puberty, relationships and the human reproduction cycle. They will also learn to have greater self-awareness and to look forward to the changes they can expect in the future.

Music

In music lessons this term, the children will be learning about the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.) through listening to music, singing and playing instruments.

History

Within our history sessions this term, we will be exploring how coastlines have been used over the past - from invaders and settlers, to smugglers, to Victorian holidays.

R.E

In our RE sessions this term we will be learning about how faith helps us when life gets hard.

Art & Design Technology

In our art lessons, the children will be drawing and painting seascapes inspired by the Japanese artist Katsushika Hokusai.
