This term we will be continuing to develop our social skills and working on our teamwork skills as we face new experiences like Sport's Day and class transitions. We will also be exploring our value for the term, respect and talking about what this means to us.

English/Literacy

We will be exploring poetry about different creatures through the book Rumble in the Jungle and designing our own creatures inspired by the Flip-Flap Safari.

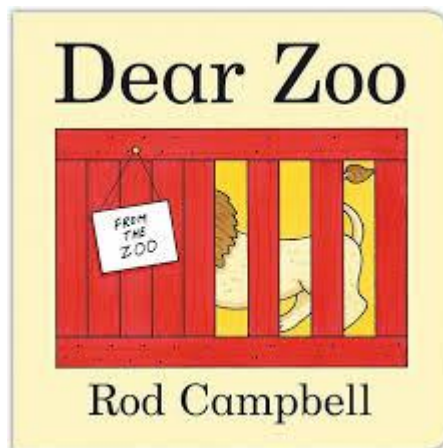
RE:

In RE this term we will be exploring the value of respect. We will also be asking the question: "What is the 'good news' that Christians believe Jesus brings?" through sharing stories from the Bible.

Communication and Language

We will be learning key vocabulary related to animals such as herbivores, omnivores, carnivores, predators and prey! We'll be thinking of ways to describe different animals and their features and adaptations.

Computing-

We will be looking at digital writing and using Google maps to explore where different animals come from.

Physical Development

This term we will be working on our gross motor skills in a range of different sports in preparation for Sports Day! We will be practising our handwriting ready for our next steps as we begin to think about our progression into Years 1 and 2. We will be exploring how our bodies respond to exercise and talk about why healthy lifestyles are so important.

Mathematics

This term we will be continuing to develop our number skills. We will be practising our number bonds to 10 and 20 and exploring the patterns in the number system looking at numbers to 100 and beyond! We will be exploring how these numbers are made from tens and ones. We will also be exploring money and adding different denominations of coins. Finally, we'll be exploring the time, exploring how time is broken down into years, months, weeks, days and then hours, minutes and seconds!

Understanding the World

Science

We will be exploring animals from around the world and learning about their adaptations to their own unique habitats. We will be revisiting animal classifications and exploring carnivores, omnivores and herbivores.

History/Geography

We will be exploring where different animals come from and looking at where they are found on a map. We will be looking at the natural features of where animals live.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be creating our own art inspired by animals, exploring their natural patterns and camouflage. We will be designing our own creatures.

Music

We will be exploring dynamics and tempo when creating our own music. We will also be exploring musical pieces inspired by different animals and creatures.
